Who is this course for?

For those who are, or are aspiring to become, a middle leader with responsibility for leading a team e.g. a key stage leader, a curriculum area leader, a pastoral services leader, a subject leader, a special educational needs co-ordinator (SENCO), or a Head of Department.

Leading a Team - Participants will lead an improvement project in a team, lasting at least 2 terms, aimed at improving pupil progress and attainment and the capability of their team.

The qualification is split across 6 areas:

- Managing Resources and Risks
- Teaching and Curriculum Excellence
- Leading with Impact
- Increasing Capability
- Working in Partnership
- Strategy and Improvement

What is included in the cost of the programme?

- One full face to face day and four late afternoon sessions
- Access to additional Online Learning Areas and all materials to complement their programme and to support their individual development
- Online discussions and support
- Two 360 diagnostic development tools (one before starting and the second towards the end), with full report and workbook to support planning for your development
- Final assessment – participants are required to:
 - Submit a written account of the project, demonstrating how they have met the criteria (4500 words)
 - Submit supporting documents and materials as evidence.

How long does the NPQML take?

The qualification can take between 12 and 18 months to complete, with a maximum study time for the whole qualification of 150 hours.

Are you eligible for a fully-funded place?

We are able to offer fully-funded places on the NPQs to those applicants working in a school in an Opportunity Area (OA), [see here](#) or a Category 5 or 6 area, [see here](#).
